### Fire Station Teteringen

A public garden in the village center is the unusual location for this new fire station. The core task of the design was to make a plain and functional building, focused on the logistics of turn-out at ground level. The building doubles as a clubhouse after stressful call-outs and as a meeting place/educational facility. A feature of this fire station is its transparency; offering views outwards as well as making the activities of the fire service visible. Wood is not the obvious choice for a fire station. However, this finish allows the building to blend into its green surroundings, and is more reminiscent of a pavilion than the usual range of industrial materials selected for this function.
